# Our Work

- A time-limited committee created at the May 2018 Tokyo Global Meeting with the passage of "1 Person, 1 Vote" to examine issues and questions around its implementation, before it goes into full effect after the DC Meeting
  - First Report issued in March
  - 3 Public Hearings by Region - we were listening
  - Second Report now posted to Wiki

# Findings

- Country committees (no matter the size) all took on challenge of 1P1V implementation in good faith!
- Many exciting reports of new members, voices, new experiences
- Challenges as well, but overall successful 1P1V adoption appears to be on track
- Having a Special Purpose Committee allowed DA as a body to gather our insights and experiences and share them with each other

# Recommendations

1. Strengthen Nominations and Elections Committees
2. Improve Recruitment and Preparation of Voting Reps, Alternates
3. Continue to Review Voting Allocation and Other Considerations as Effects of 1P1V Become More Clear
4. Improve Remote Participation, including Improvement of the WebEx Experience (“One Room” Experience)
5. We ask the DPCA to Extend the Work of this Committee

# Motion

- Motion to extend the work of the 1P1V Special Purpose Committee through the 2021 Global Meeting, with members to be appointed by the International Chair, in order to:
  - Research and disseminate information on NEC practices and improving recruitment and orientation of Voting Representatives and Alternates;
  - Consider means of strengthening meaningful remote participation including via WebEx; and
  - Continue to review voting allocation and other related considerations
  - And examine other issues as the DPCA or ExCom may refer to it
